What will the Summer 2023 tuition rates be for GWC?

There will be no tuition charged for Summer 2023 courses held on the GWC campus. Rates as posted on the Aurora University websites for main campus, Online and Woodstock still apply.

Per course lab and other standard fees may still apply.

Fall 2023 tuition will be the rates as posted on the AU website - \$14,000/term.

What will the housing and dining costs be for GWC?

Summer and Fall 2023 GWC housing and dining rates will stay the same as those charged for Spring 2023 as follows:

Housing (per semester)

Single	\$3,800
Standard	\$2,770
Expanded	\$1,960

Note: Very few, if any, Singles will be available. Student housing will be consolidated to Oak and Hickory for the Summer and Fall.

Dining (per semester)

Unlimited	\$2,685
Residential 15	\$2,510
Residential 10	\$1,500
JR/SR 80	\$1,015

Supplemental aid for those who do not receive enough Summer aid?

Per above, all tuition for courses held on the GWC campus is waived. Students eligible for federal grants and loans may still apply for aid to offset housing and dining costs.

Summer aid application?

Financial aid will work individually with any student planning to live on campus for Summer 2023 who would like to explore aid to offset housing and dining costs.

When can students find out what they are eligible for in summer to help with their decision-making process?

Financial aid will work individually with any student planning to live on campus for Summer 2023 who would like to explore aid to offset housing and dining costs. As noted above, there will be no summer tuition charges.

What does free housing mean for main campus?

AU will offer a billing credit to offset any campus housing charges to any GWC transfer student living in university housing for any room selection as long as they live on campus. Standard published dining rates will still apply.
